



TRIOLOGICAL SOCIETY MEETINGS TRAVEL AWARDS FOR RESIDENTS, MEDICAL STUDENTS, AND FELLOWS COMBINED SECTIONS MEETING AND ANNUAL MEETING AT COSM

TRAVEL AWARDS FOR RESIDENTS

To help offset travel expenses incurred by residents chosen to make presentations at Triological Society meetings, travel funds in the amount of \$750 will be awarded to training programs for each resident* selected for a podium or poster presentation.

Residents must meet the following criteria:

- The resident must indicate resident status and name of training program in the appropriate boxes on the online abstract submission form.
- The resident must be the first author and presenter as listed on the abstract and any subsequent submissions to *The Laryngoscope* or *Laryngoscope Investigative Otolaryngology*.
- The resident must be a Triological Society Resident member (you do not have to resubmit an application if you are already a Triological Society Resident member). Applications are available at www.triological.org and must be completed/submitted no later than **September 10th for Combined Sections Meeting in January and by October 31st for Annual Meeting at COSM in April.**
- The resident must be in an accredited residency training program at time of submission and presentation.
- The resident must register for and attend the Triological Society meeting.

Residents may receive only one travel award per meeting, regardless of the number of presentations being made at the Triological Society sessions. Residents are eligible for travel awards for both the Combined Sections meeting in January and the Annual meeting held at COSM in April.

Travel awards will be issued to the department/institution at the conclusion of the meeting. An award of \$750 will be made for each resident who has fulfilled the above criteria and upon completion of required documents by the department/institution. **Residents residing in the city where the meeting is held do not qualify for travel awards.*

Travel awards are “automatic” if all criteria have been met. All criteria will be verified AFTER the end of the meeting. There is no application process for the travel awards.

TRAVEL AWARDS FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS

To help offset travel expenses incurred by medical students chosen to make presentations at Triological Society meetings, travel funds in the amount of \$750 will be awarded to training programs for each medical student* selected for a podium or poster presentation.

Medical Students must meet the following criteria:

- The student must indicate student status and name of training program in the appropriate boxes on the online abstract submission form.
- The medical student must be the first author and presenter as listed on the abstract and any subsequent submissions to *The Laryngoscope* or *Laryngoscope Investigative Otolaryngology*.
- The medical student must submit a Triological Society Student Verification form. The form is available at www.triological.org and must be completed/submitted no later than **September 10th for Combined Sections Meeting in January and by October 31st for Annual Meeting at COSM in April.**
- The medical student must register for and attend the Triological Society meeting (this criteria has been put into place due to the number of presenters selected for poster presentations who do not register for and/or attend the meeting).

Medical students may receive only one travel award per meeting, regardless of the number of presentations being made at the Triological Society sessions. Medical students are eligible for travel awards for both the Combined Sections meeting in January and the Annual meeting held at COSM in April.

Travel awards will be issued to the department/institution at the conclusion of the meeting. To help offset travel expenses incurred by Fellows chosen to make presentations at Triological Society meetings, travel funds in the amount of \$750 will be awarded to training programs for each Fellow* selected for a podium or poster presentation.

Fellows must meet the following criteria:

- The Fellow must indicate Fellow status and name of training program in the appropriate boxes on the online abstract submission form.
- The Fellow must be the first author and presenter as listed on the abstract and any subsequent submissions to *The Laryngoscope* or *Laryngoscope Investigative Otolaryngology*.
- The Fellow must be a Triological Society Post-Graduate member (you do not have to resubmit an application if you are already a Triological Society Post-Graduate member). Applications are available at www.triological.org and must be completed/submitted no later than **September 10th for Combined Sections Meeting in January and by October 31st for Annual Meeting at COSM in April.**
- The Fellow must be in an accredited Fellowship training program at time of submission and presentation.
- The Fellow must register for and attend the Triological Society meeting (this criteria has been put into place due to the number of presenters selected for poster presentations who do not register for and/or attend the meeting).

Fellows may receive only one travel award per meeting, regardless of the number of presentations being made at the Triological Society sessions. Fellows are eligible for travel awards for both the Combined Sections meeting in January and the Annual meeting held at COSM in April.
