## FEBRUARY 2020

Submission to one of the two Triological Society journals is required upon approval of all theses. These authors can choose to submit to either journal: *The Laryngoscope* or *Laryngoscope Investigative Otolaryngology*. Acceptance of your thesis by the Council does not guarantee acceptance of your thesis for publication in either journal. All theses are subject to the peer-review and acceptance/rejection policies of the selected journal.

#### 2. *Supplement to The Laryngoscope* – print and online\*

- ✓ No word/reference/figure/table page limit
- ✓ Copyright assigned by author to Triological Society
- ✓ Fee: Based on number of pages and use of color
- ✓ Supplements are suggested if you don't want a word/page limit, or if you wish to have your thesis prepared as a separate and standalone publication with its own cover.
- ✓ [Author Guidelines](#)
- ✓ The guidelines will indicate word limits, but if you choose a supplement they can be exceeded.
- ✓ Contact Kurt Polesky at [kpolesky@wiley.com](mailto:kpolesky@wiley.com) advising him that you are interested in publishing your thesis as a Supplement and attach your manuscript. Kurt will provide a price quote and if you accept it and sign an agreement, you will be advised to submit to the Journal's online submission system and follow the instructions above. Kurt will advise the Editorial Office that you have chosen the supplement option.
